

## Terms of use of the Women4Cyber™ logo

The use of the Women4Cyber logo is subject to you agreeing to the following terms:

1. ECSO is the sole owner of the Women4Cyber logo. Your use of the logo acknowledges ECSO's ownership of the logo.
2. ECSO, and its Women4Cyber Foundation, reserves the right to take action against any use of the logo that does not conform to any of the conditions herein, or that infringes any intellectual property or other rights of ECSO or violates the applicable law. All use of or goodwill associated with the logo will convey to the benefit of ECSO and the Women4Cyber Foundation.
3. Use of the logo by partners should be done within the scope of a previously established partnership agreement.
4. Use of the logo does not indicate or create any endorsement, approval, sponsorship or affiliation of or with your website by ECSO and the Women4Cyber Foundation.
5. The logo is provided without warranties of any kind, express or implied, including without limitation, warranties of title of non- infringement. Use of the logo is solely at your own risk.
6. ECSO and the Women4Cyber Foundation hereby grant you a license to use the logo, provided that you agree that:
  - a) The logo will be used solely in the context of an established partnership agreement, following the terms of this agreement.
  - b) The logo will always be linked to the ECSO website (and later on to the Women4Cyber website when available) and the link will always be an active link.
  - c) The logo will always stand alone and will not be combined with any other graphical elements.
  - d) The logo will not be altered in any manner including its size, proportions, font, design, arrangement, colours or elements or animated, morphed or otherwise distorted in perspective or appearance.
  - e) The logo will not appear more prominently than your personal, company, product or service website name.
  - f) The logo will be displayed in a positive manner and will not be used in any way that adversely affects ECSO and the Women4Cyber Foundation.
  - g) You will not transfer, assign, sell, reproduce, distribute or otherwise exploit your link to us or your use of our logo.
  - h) The logo will appear as provided by the Women4Cyber Secretariat.
  - i) The use should not be linked to aims, activities or events incompatible with the principles and objectives of ECSO and the Women4Cyber Foundation; under no circumstances may the logo be reproduced for illegal ends which are contrary to public decency.



- j) It is understood that the user of the logo shall not acquire and shall not claim any title to the logo which is the subject of this authorisation.
  - k) The logo will not create or give the appearance of creating an endorsement, approval, sponsorship, affiliation or recommendation of any product or service by ECSO and the Women4Cyber Foundation, unless specified in a previously established agreement between the Women4Cyber Foundation and the concerned party.
  - l) Unless specifically instructed and given the approval to do so by the W4C Foundation Administration Body, the user shall not register or seek to register any trademark or name which contains the logo, or which is so similar to the logo as to be likely to cause deception or confusion. In doing so, you will expose yourself to a legal pursuit, as the Women4Cyber logo has been trademarked by ECSO.
  - m) The logo will not be used or displayed in any way that disparages ECSO and the Women4Cyber Foundation, infringes any intellectual property or other rights of ECSO and of the Women4Cyber Foundation, violates any national or international laws, or diminishes or otherwise damages ECSO's and the Women4Cyber Foundation's goodwill in the logo.
7. ECSO and the Women4Cyber Foundation reserve the right to make any change to the information and/or license provided herein at any time for any reason. You acknowledge and agree that you are responsible for keeping up with any such changes.
  8. The ECSO and/or the Women4Cyber Foundation may terminate this agreement immediately without notice if, in their sole judgment, the user has breached any terms or conditions of this agreement. In such case you agree to remove the link and stop the use of the logo immediately. You will be prohibited from reinstating the link or using the logo without further written permission from ECSO and/or the Women4Cyber Foundation.
